First Confession

First Confession will take place in St Oliver Plunkett's church on Thursday 22nd February @6pm. Children are to go directly to the church with their families wearing their full school uniform that evening. The P4 children can wear sports gear to school on Thursday 22nd February to prevent their uniform from getting dirty.

Confirmation

Confirmation will take place in St Oliver Plunkett's church on Friday 8th March @1.30pm. The children can stay at home on the morning of their confirmation and go directly to the church with their families – they will be marked present on the day and their attendance will not be affected. If this is not convenient for parents, your child is welcome to come to school as normal and will walk to the church with our school choir. The P7 children can wear their own clothes on the day of their confirmation. Our school photographer will be available on the day to take photographs during the service and afterwards in our school. Light refreshments will be served in our school hall whilst waiting for your family photograph to be taken.
