Sports Day is planned to take place at St. Oliver Plunkett's GAC, on Tuesday 31st May. Please <u>leave your child to school at the normal time</u> and they will be accompanied by their class teachers to the pavilion for 9.30am.

All children will take part in the traditional sports. Activities will be completed by 12.30pm and the canteen will be providing a **special sports day 'Happy Meal'** which can be ordered and paid for on our ParentMail App. Children can bring their own packed lunch if they prefer. This will be eaten at the pitch.

We also require children to bring their own **healthy snack** for break time as there will be no toast available.

Please note: P.1 & P.2 will be collected from the pavilion at 2pm. Older siblings can go home at this time if it suits.

Children should come to school in their sports gear. Parents please apply sun cream to your child on the morning of sports day. Peaked caps should also be worn and a bottle of water is required!

The children will be divided into Key Stages and will stay in their 'zones' for the duration of Sport's Day. <u>We request that all parents remain outside the</u> <u>perimeter fence for child protection reasons</u>. Children will remain in their zone as they are required to be ready when called to participate in their race.

Parents may avail of tea/coffee throughout the day, which will be provided by the Camogie club.

Please note: We request that parents provide a special **nut free** treat for their child to eat at break-time. Children should bring their treat and drink in a lunch bag. (Bins will be placed beside each class for pupil use and there will be bins available outside the perimeter fence for adult use. We would greatly appreciate your help in ensuring the grounds of the club are left tidy after our use.)
