School Funds

Breakfast Club & School opening

Our new breakfast club has started this week and is proving to be very popular. It runs from 8am - 8.45am at a cost of £1 per child per day. This includes toast, cereal and juice. Payment can be made to Christine or Karen daily or weekly. If not attending the breakfast club children are not permitted to attend school until 8.45am.



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Car Park and Collecting Children

To prevent any congestion and for the safety of all the children leaving school, parents are asked to park in a suitable place when collecting children - not at railings where the traffic cones are set. All parents are asked to turn LEFT when exiting the car park. This will prevent any congestion when parents are trying to enter the car park to collect their children. This is a persistent problem and your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Homework

As a result of the feedback of the questionnaires distributed to parents last year, we have redrafted our homework policy and amended homework schedules at whole school level. Homework will be given out weekly and no longer on a daily basis. Additional work will be available for your child via our school website under the 'Homework' section (available week commencing 9^{th} September). Parents are asked to familiarise themselves with their child's homework schedule and ensure it is completed and ready to be submitted at the end of the week. This will be rolled out to parents on the week beginning 16^{th} September. If you have any queries in relation to homework please contact your child's class teacher.

Keeping Parents Informed on Pupil Progress

We aim to ensure all parents are kept informed of their child's progress through the school year and we continue to strive to ensure parents are involved in their child's/children's development. Please note the following:

<u>Curriculum Evening</u> - This will take place on **9**th **October**. Parents will be invited to a meeting with your child's class teacher where initiatives, targets and objectives for the year will be discussed.

<u>Parent Teacher Meetings</u> - This will take place later in the year in January (term 2) <u>Books Sent Home</u> - Your child's numeracy and literacy books will be sent home every half term for parents to enjoy their child's class work produced throughout the year. If you have any concerns regarding your child's progress or any other matter contact your child's class teacher to arrange a meeting throughout the school year.

After Schools Clubs

We will introduce ASC for all children from Monday 16th September. We are delighted to offer Spanish again this year and would also like to offer weekly tin whistle lessons for KS1 (P3/4) & KS2 (P5/6/7) children. Further details on the Spanish club will be sent home next week. If you would like your child to avail of the after school's tin whistle club that will take place every Monday 3pm-4pm, please complete



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the reply slip below. A small fee is necessary to cover the expenses of the language and music tutors.

Mr Meehan and Mrs R. Quinn will facilitate an after schools club for KS1 (P3/4) & KS2 (P5/6/7) children beginning Thursday 19th September from 3pm-4pm. Mr Meehan will run a music club for KS2 children exploring world music, making percussion instruments and creating music via garage band. Mrs Quinn will run a Fun Maths club for KS1 children focussing on problem solving and mental maths activities, all done through interactive games. There is no charge for the Thursday clubs.
